

TOWN OF JEFFERSON

NOVEMBER 2025 TOWN BOARD MEETING

The regular monthly meeting of the Town of Jefferson was called to order at 6:00 p.m. on November 12, 2025, at the Juda Community Center. In attendance were Kurt Jordan, Rick Nusbaum, Nathan Weber, Amy McCullough, and Joe Jones.

Rick verified notices had been posted at the Juda Post Office, the Juda Community Center, and at the Recycling Garage. A notice was also published on the Town of Jefferson's website.

For public input:

- There was some discussion on snow removal around the Juda Community Center and the Juda Fire Station. Kurt will look into some options.
- A dusk to dawn light will be installed on the east wall of the town garage to shine on the bank parking lot.

The 2026 budget was reviewed with Nathan making a motion to approve. Kurt seconded and the motion carried.

The Clerk's report was reviewed with Nathan making a motion to approve. Kurt seconded and the motion carried. There was no other correspondence.

After some discussion, Kurt made a motion to sign a two-year contract with Bruce Gardiner Appraisal Service. Nathan seconded and the motion carried.

The Treasurer's report was reviewed, noting cash on hand as of October 31, 2025, at \$136,259.43. Kurt made a motion and Nathan seconded to accept the report. Motion carried.

The planning commission had nothing to report.

For road maintenance, Joe has finished putting up snow fence and has been trimming trees. He will soon be getting the snow plows ready for the season. There were no driveway permits to report.

The bills were circulated through board members. Kurt made a motion and Nathan seconded to approve payment of bills. Motion carried.

The next meeting will be on Wednesday, December 10, 2025, at 6:00 p.m.

The meeting was adjourned on a motion by Nathan and a second by Kurt. Motion carried.
