

Notice: Election Update for Town of Jefferson

Beginning with the next election, voters in the Town of Jefferson will experience a change at their polling place: traditional paper poll books are being replaced by Badger Books, which are secure electronic poll book systems.

With Badger Books, election workers will check in voters using a computer instead of a paper list. This system is designed to make the voter check-in process faster and more accurate, while maintaining all existing voter eligibility rules and safeguards.

For voters, the check-in process will remain very familiar. You will still approach the poll table, state your name and address, and present your voter ID as required by law. Your ballot and voting options will not change, and no voting history is stored in the Badger Books system. Election officials stress that Badger Books are secure, are used only for voter check-in, and are not connected to voting machines or the internet while polls are open.
